

## Bowel Cancer Survivors' Work Participation Survey

You may be eligible if:

- You are between 18 and 65 years old; and
- You were diagnosed with stage 1 to 3 bowel cancer within the past 5 years and have no evidence of any cancer after your surgery and other cancer treatment; and
- You were in the paid job market at the time of diagnosis (full-time or part-time).

This survey contains questions about you, your cancer diagnosis, work-related questions before or at the time of diagnosis, and after treatment. This survey will take about 15-20 minutes to complete. You only have to take this survey once and your answers are completely anonymous.
